Current Income Information (within 30 days) <i>Please bring one of the following:</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pay stub • Unemployment • Disability • Social Security • Bank statement • Student loans grants • Tax return are required if you are a business owner or self employed 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Workers comp • Child support Letter • If unemployed, you may bring a supporting letter stating you are not working along with the signers address and telephone number
Social Security card <i>Please bring one of the following:</i>	Must bring for every family member even if the children have private insurance or legal documentation including income taxes or letter from social security office.	
Proof of Citizenship or Proof of Residency	United States passport only (For consumers born in the United States.) Green Card Naturalization Certificate (For consumers who are citizens through naturalization.) Needed for every family member	
Birth Certificate	Must bring for every family member even if the children have private insurance.	
Written proof of pregnancy (if applicable)	From a clinic or hospital.	
Prenatal presumptive OR Medical Card (if applicable)	Temporary medical identification card	

If you do not have all documentation at the time of your visit, you will have to schedule a future appointment.
