<b>Current Income Information (within 30 days)</b>  <i>Please bring one of the following:</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Pay stub</li> <li>• Unemployment</li> <li>• Disability</li> <li>• Social Security</li> <li>• Bank statement</li> <li>• Student loans grants</li> <li>• Tax return are required if you are a business owner or self employed</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Workers comp</li> <li>• Child support Letter</li> <li>• If unemployed, you may bring a supporting letter stating you are not working along with the signers address and telephone number</li> </ul>
<b>Social Security card</b>  <i>Please bring one of the following:</i>	Must bring for every family member even if the children have private insurance or legal documentation including income taxes or letter from social security office.	
<b>Proof of Citizenship or Proof of Residency</b>	United States passport only (For consumers born in the United States.) Green Card Naturalization Certificate (For consumers who are citizens through naturalization.) Needed for every family member	
<b>Birth Certificate</b>	Must bring for every family member even if the children have private insurance.	
<b>Written proof of pregnancy (if applicable)</b>	From a clinic or hospital.	
<b>Prenatal presumptive OR Medical Card (if applicable)</b>	Temporary medical identification card	

*If you do not have all documentation at the time of your visit, you will have to schedule a future appointment.*
