Prepare for wildfire smoke

Wildfire smoke that gets inside your home can make indoor air unhealthy. To prepare for wildfire smoke events:

- Weatherize the home by sealing the openings
- Create a clean air room at home where the air is filtered and smoke can't get in.
 Use a MERV 13 or greater filter in your HVAC system.
- Go to the nearest clean air center in your area if you can't seal your home and dense smoke get in

Create cleaner indoor air

A box fan fitted with a MERV 13 air filter is an affordable and effective option to clean the air if you can't find an air purifier. It works to capture the air of smoke, mold, pollen, bacteria and virus particles, and more.
