Tradition Three states that the only requirement for membership in Al-Anon is that there be a problem of alcoholism in a relative or friend. The message of the Al-Anon Family Groups is one of hope. It is the story of men and women who once felt helpless, lost and lonely because of the alcoholism of a loved one. Today, these men and women have courage and confidence. They have learned about simple things they can do to help themselves which, indirectly, can help their alcoholic relative, whether sober or not. They have found understanding friends. Teenage groups, known as Alateen, are a vital part of the Al-Anon Family Groups. Young people seeking help with problems that arise when alcoholism afflicts a parent, close relative or friend, meet to exchange experiences and to gain understanding of the alcoholic. This helps them to keep their own lives and personal development from being affected too deeply by association with an alcoholic.
